Rules and Restrictions

Remember...we want church camp to be fun, but at the same time give our **Lord all that is due him**. Please come with a smile and a good attitude. It will be a time you will always remember.

Rules and Restrictions imposed by the property owner (Coos County Parks)

- Users of the park must comply with all posted signs and obey speed rules. Day Use/Picnic areas close at dusk. Quiet time in the main campground is from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m. Check out time is noon. Automobiles, trailers, or other vehicles shall be parked only in designated parking areas. No vehicles shall be driven or parked on the grass. No fire shall be built, lit or maintained except in a camp stove or a fireplace designated for such purposes. User shall extinguish all fires when not attended. No person shall pick or mutilate any foliage, nor mutilate any park structures. **Vandalism** – violators will be prosecuted. No person shall discharge any firearm in the park. The abuse of alcoholic liquors is prohibited in the park. No person shall use abusive, threatening, boisterous, vile, obscene, or indecent language or gestures within a park. No person shall operate or use any noise producing machine, vehicle, or instrument in such a manner that is disturbing to other park users. No bands, amplified music or public address systems are allowed in the park without prior permission of the Parks Director. Pets shall be secured by a leash not over 10 feet long and shall not be left unattended in the park. No dogs are allowed in the Day Use/Picnic area; and only seeing-eye dogs are allowed in any park building. No person shall ride, lead, or otherwise keep a saddle horse or other animal in the park.
- No garbage shall be left in the park, except in the receptacles designated for that purpose. No person shall bring home garbage for the purpose of leaving it therein. No person shall clean any seafood, except at places designated by the Parks Dept. Users will be charged for any damage, repairs, and excessive clean-up costs attributable to your use of the park. In order to enforce all rules and regulations, and to maintain a sanitary and orderly appearance in the park, a designated Park Employee is vested with the authority to require all users to abide by such rules and regulations, as well as the authority to monitor the arrangement of individual camping facilities in the park. He/she may eject anyone from the park who will not conform to park regulations. He/she may revoke any permit when there is reasonable cause to believe the permit holder has violated any provisions of the permit, park regulations or state law.

General Rules

- **NO drugs and NO alcohol** will be allowed in the West Laverne Park section, including RVs, tents, and vehicles, nor on the grounds. Failure to abide by this restriction could result in you being asked to leave the premises. There will be designated area(s) for those who choose to smoke. Observe the boundaries of the West Laverne Park section. Campers will be expected to keep their church/family group informed of their whereabouts and comings and goings.
- Please conduct yourself as becoming a child of God at all times. This includes your appearance. Modest clothing without offensive slogans/sayings and/or graphics are requested. Clothing is not to show undergarments or body areas that undergarments are designed to cover. Likewise, swimwear should be conservative and not expose private areas of the body. No hats are to be worn during the evening worship services.
- Campers are discouraged from bringing large amounts of cash, electronic devices or other valuables. If campers have any such items, that they need secured for safe keeping, please have them address this issue with the church/family group they are attending with. The First Missionary Baptist Church of Coquille will not be held responsible for any lost/damaged valuables that are brought by campers. *(Note: A CD player may be available for use with special music.)*
